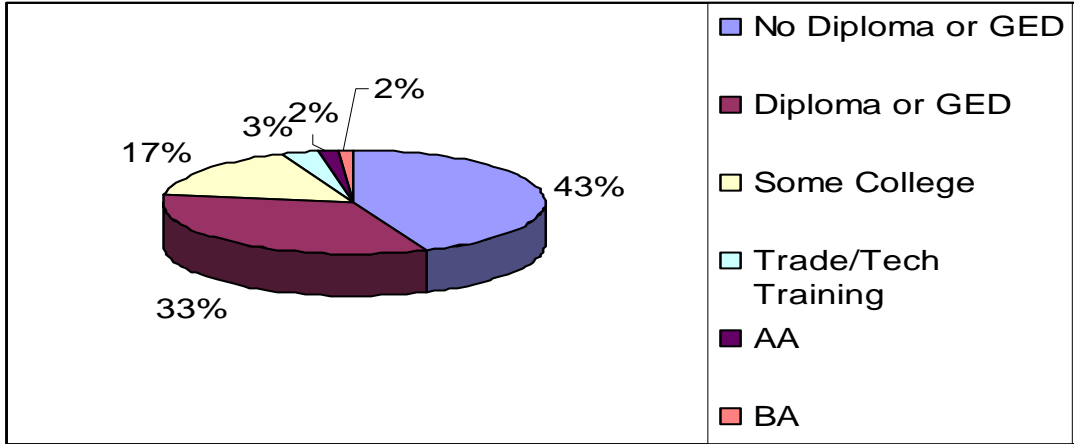
RACE OF ADULTS IN FAMILIES SERVED:



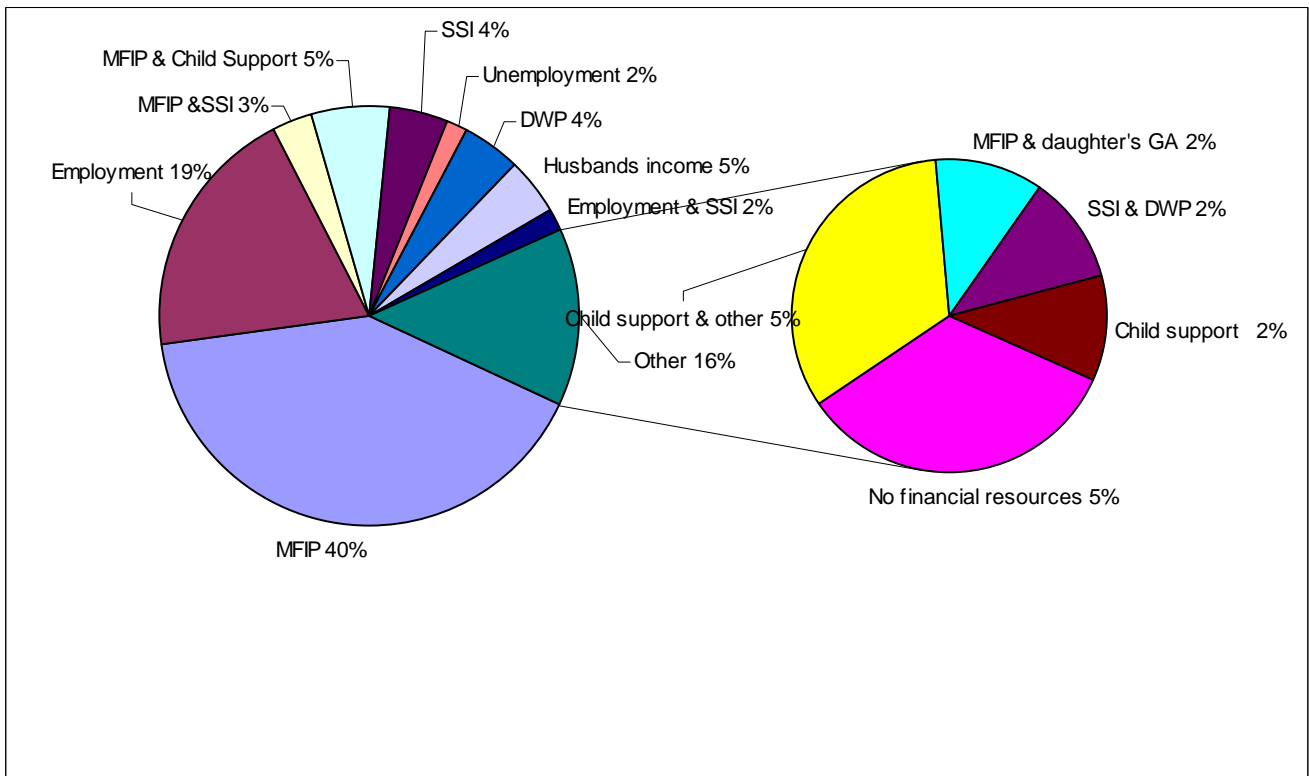

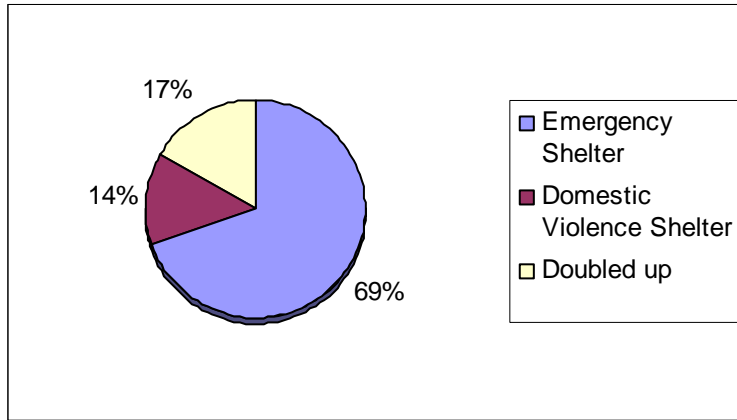

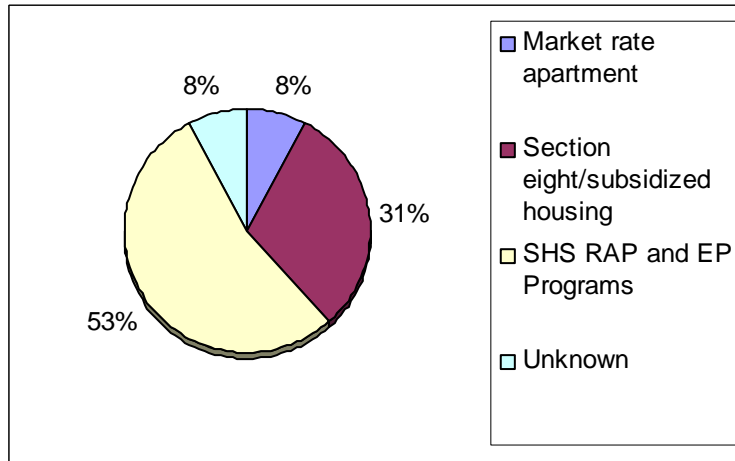


Participant families were terminated for reasons including: eviction and non compliance with program rules and regulations.

Participant families left the program voluntarily for reasons including: One relocated out of state for a new start. One relocated out of state due to safety concerns and one household voluntarily exited due to separating.

OF THOSE FAMILIES THAT COMPLETED THE PROGRAM:

13 families



One participant completed the program giving proper notice to exit but did not provide SHS with any forwarding information on where she and her family would be moving at the time of their exit from the program.

Income:

- 67% of families showed increased income
- AVERAGE MONTHLY INCOME AT ENTRANCE: \$619
- AVERAGE MONTHLY INCOME AT EXIT: \$885

Employment/Education:

- 37% of non-disabled TH families were working upon program exit
- 55% of non-disabled TH families were working or in school upon program exit
 - **Of those completing, 13% were employed or in school at entrance**

Stability:

- 80% of participants developed and followed a budget
- 34% of participants attended counseling
 - **6% had attended counseling prior**
- 100% of participants developed support networks
 - **67% had support networks prior**

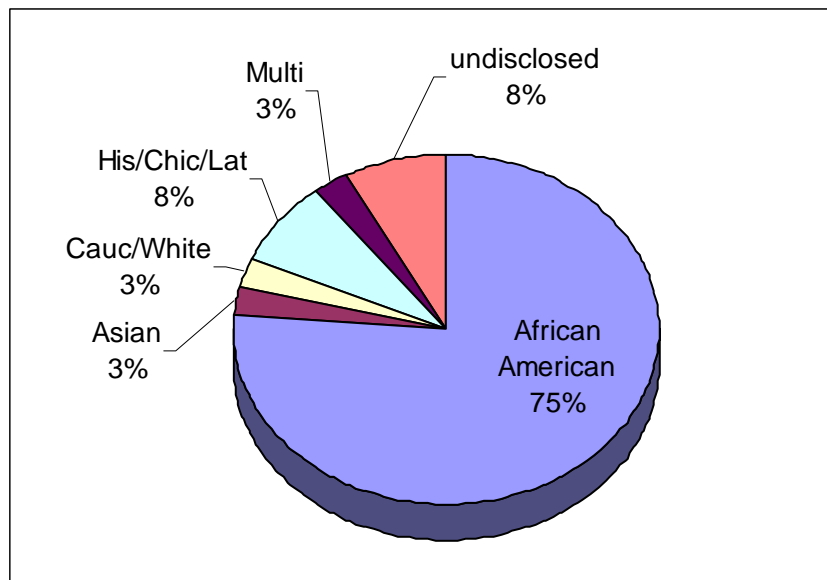

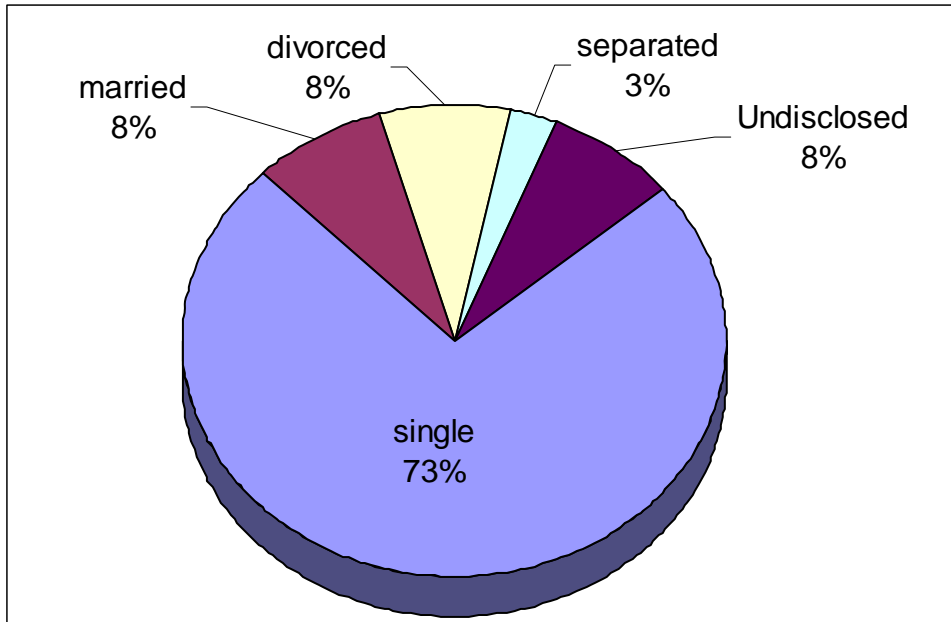

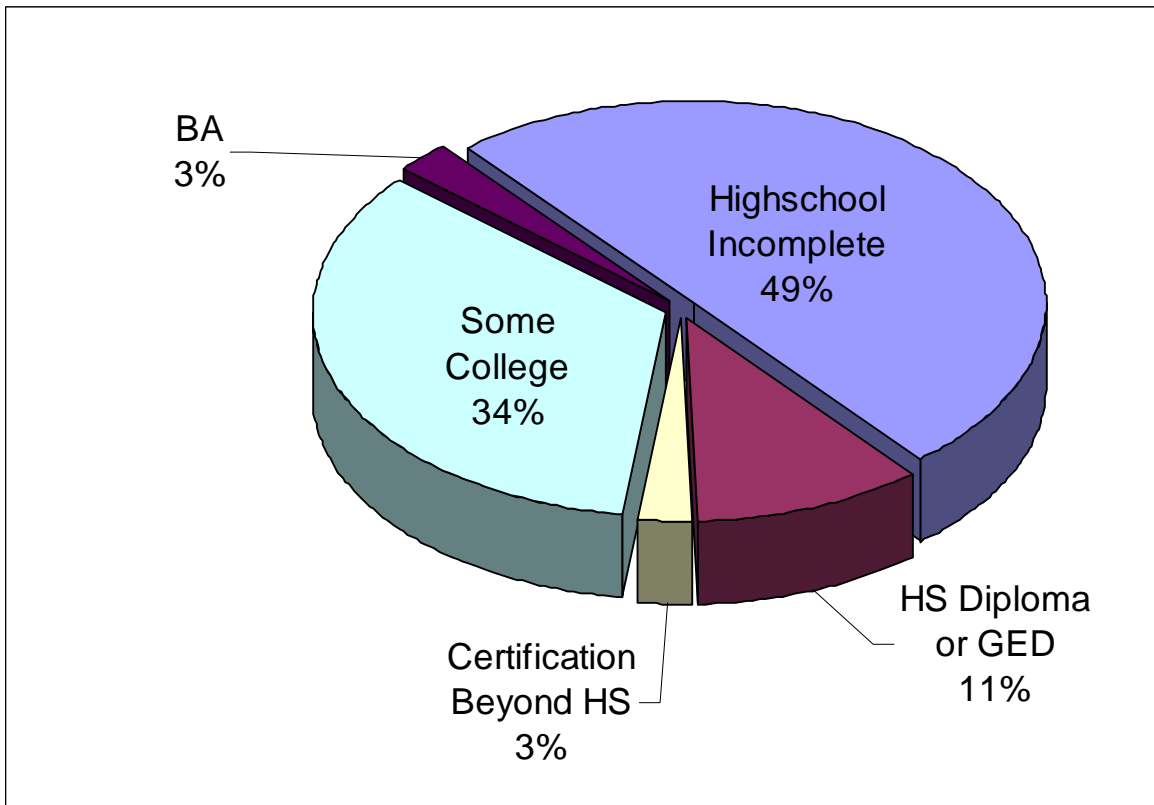
RACE OF ADULTS IN FAMILIES SERVED:



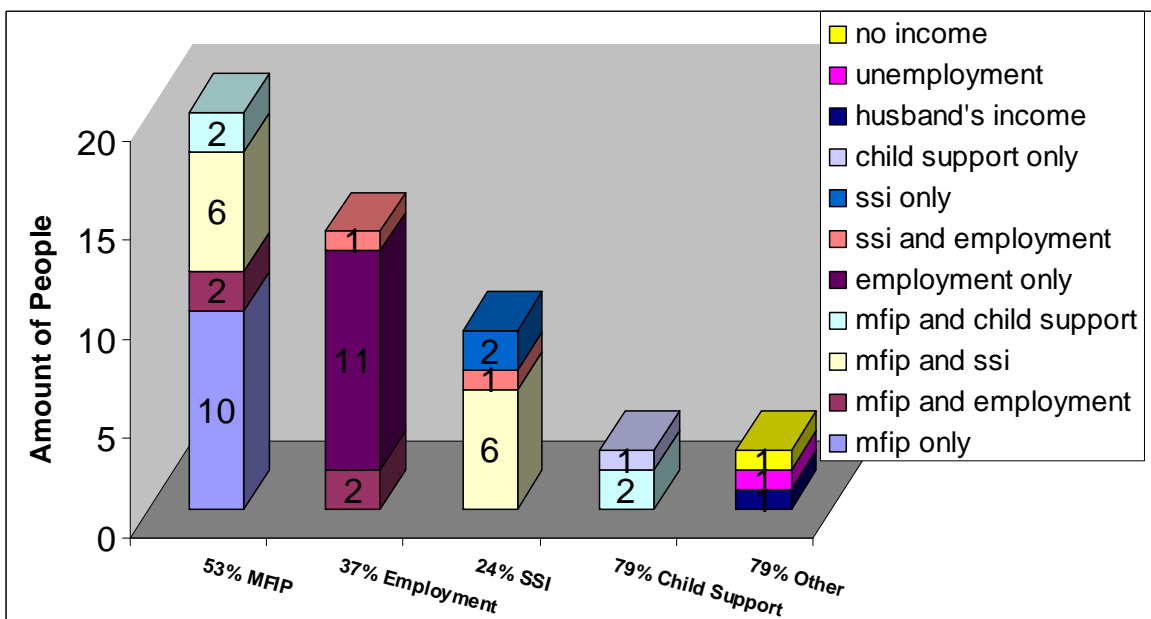
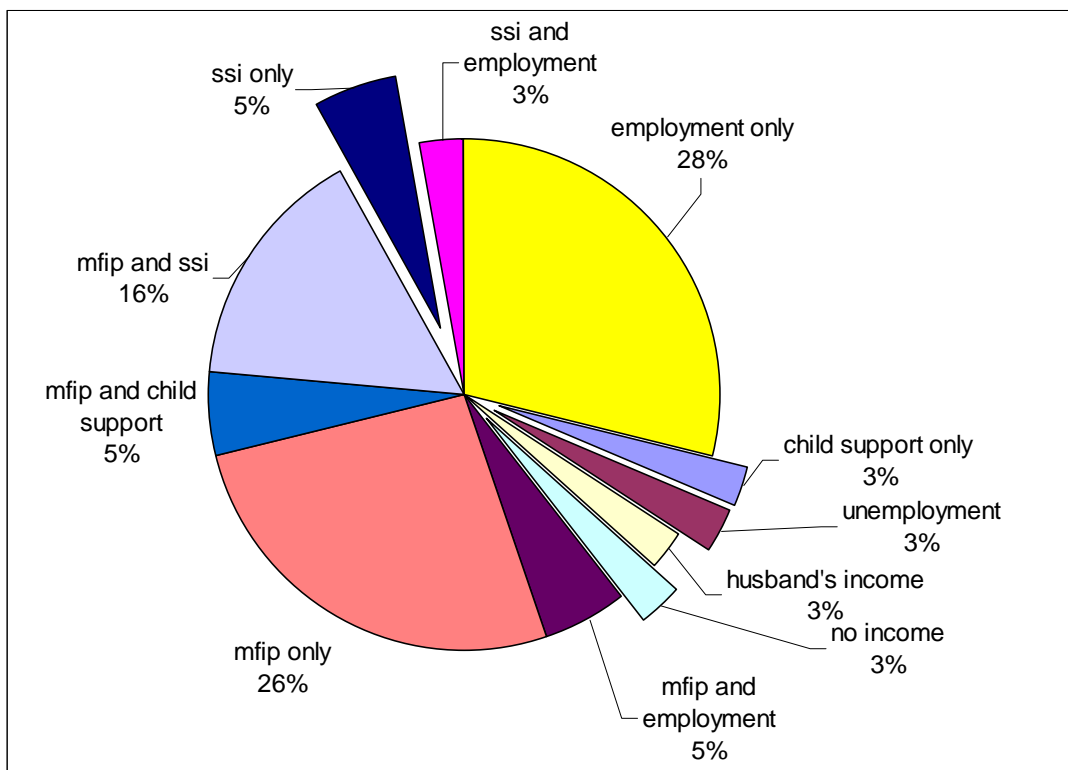

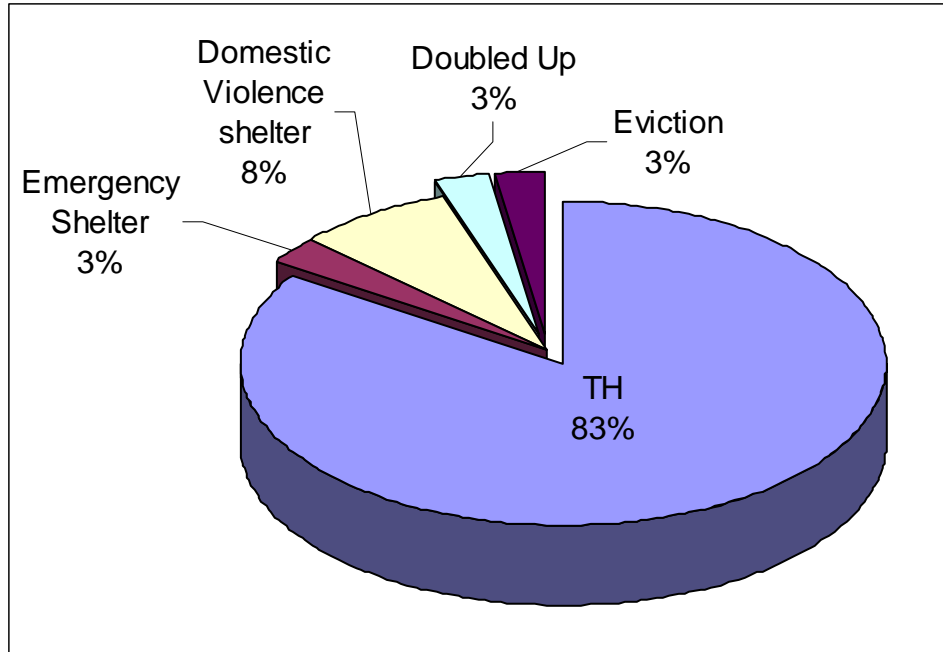
LEVEL OF EDUCATION AT ENTRANCE:



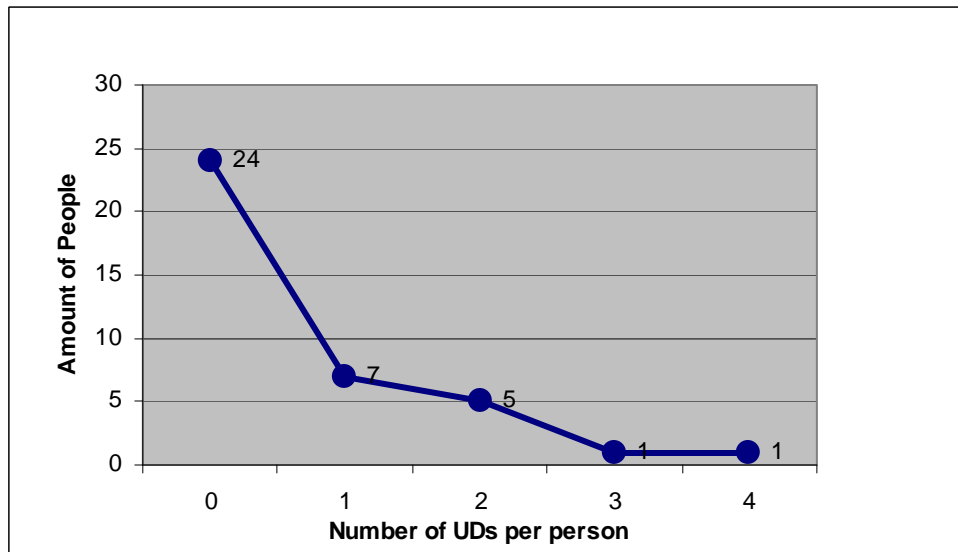

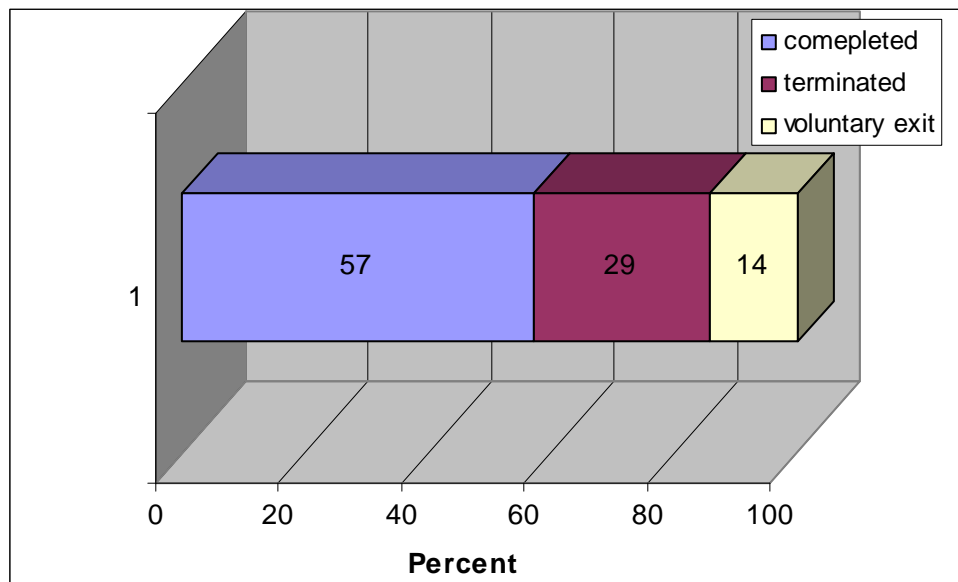

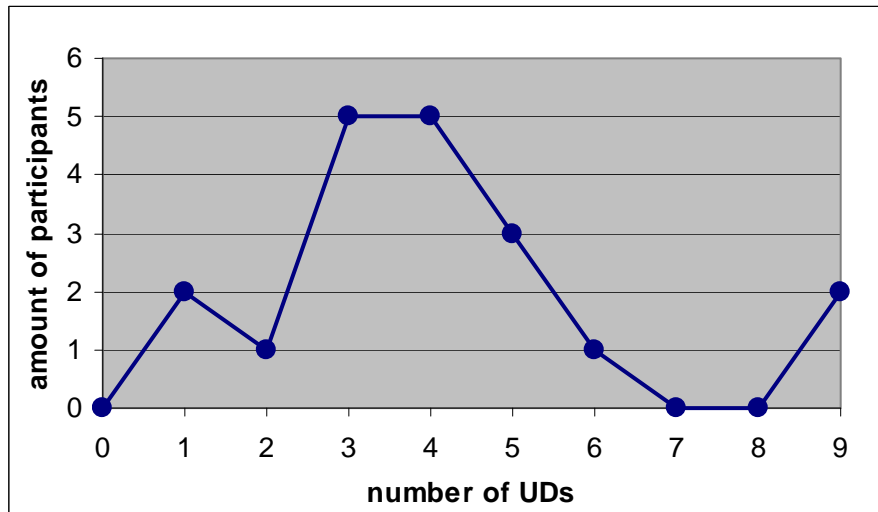

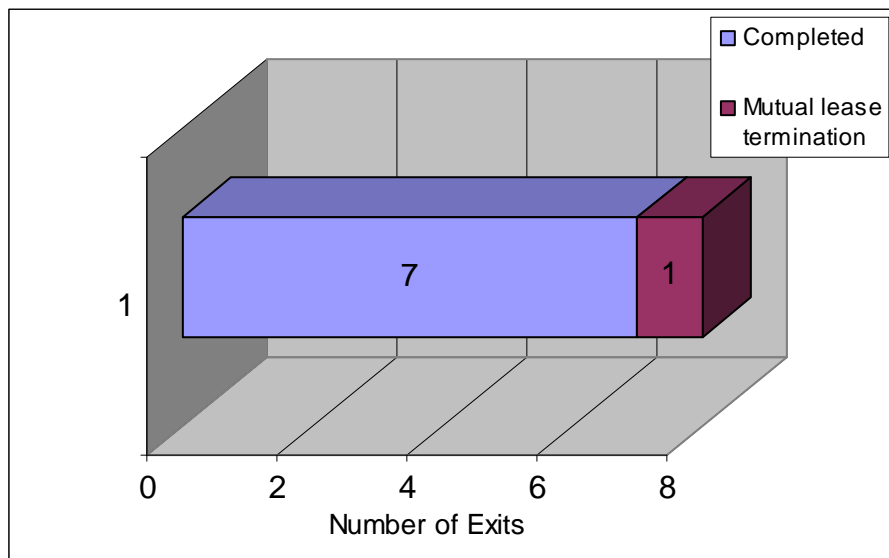

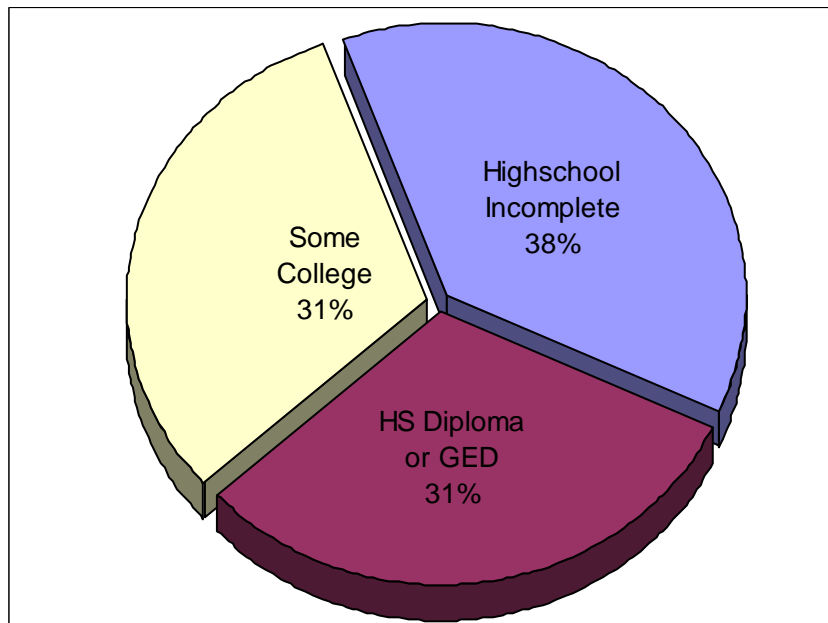
RACE OF ADULTS IN FAMILIES SERVED:



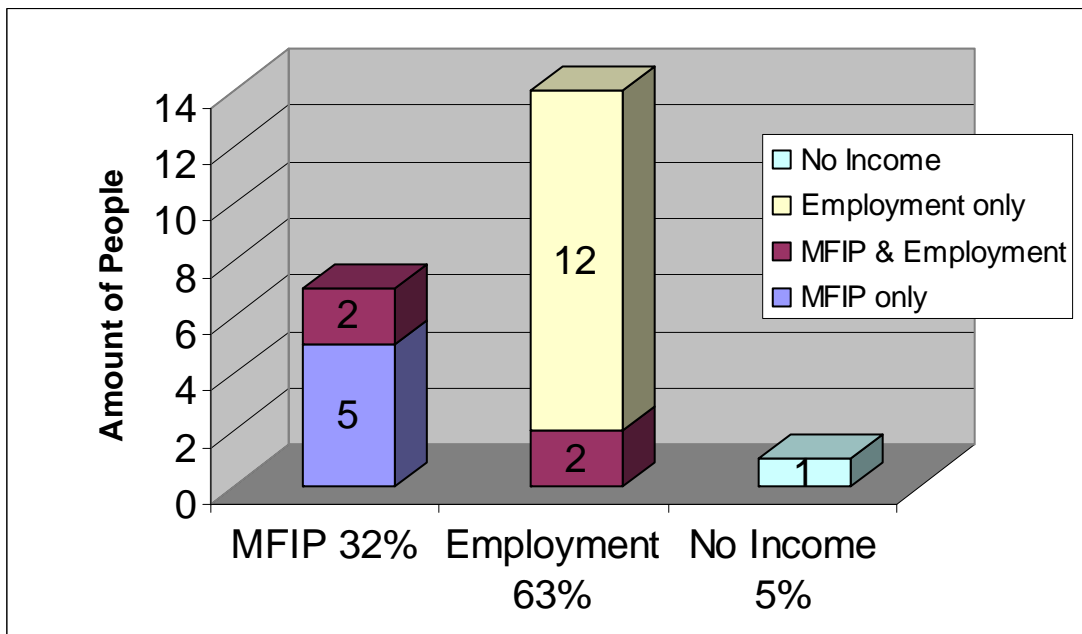
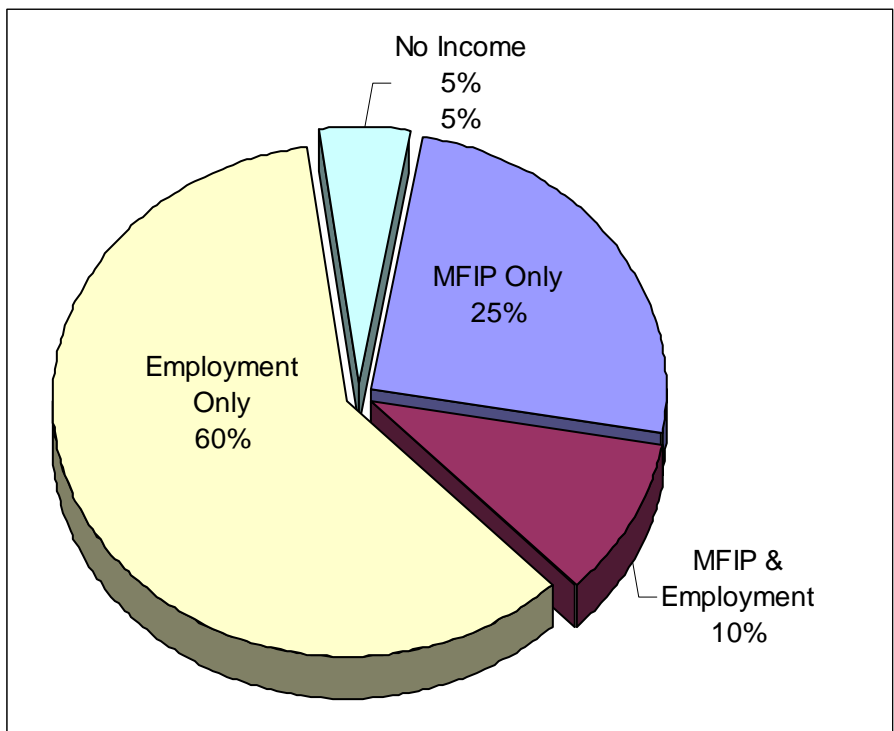

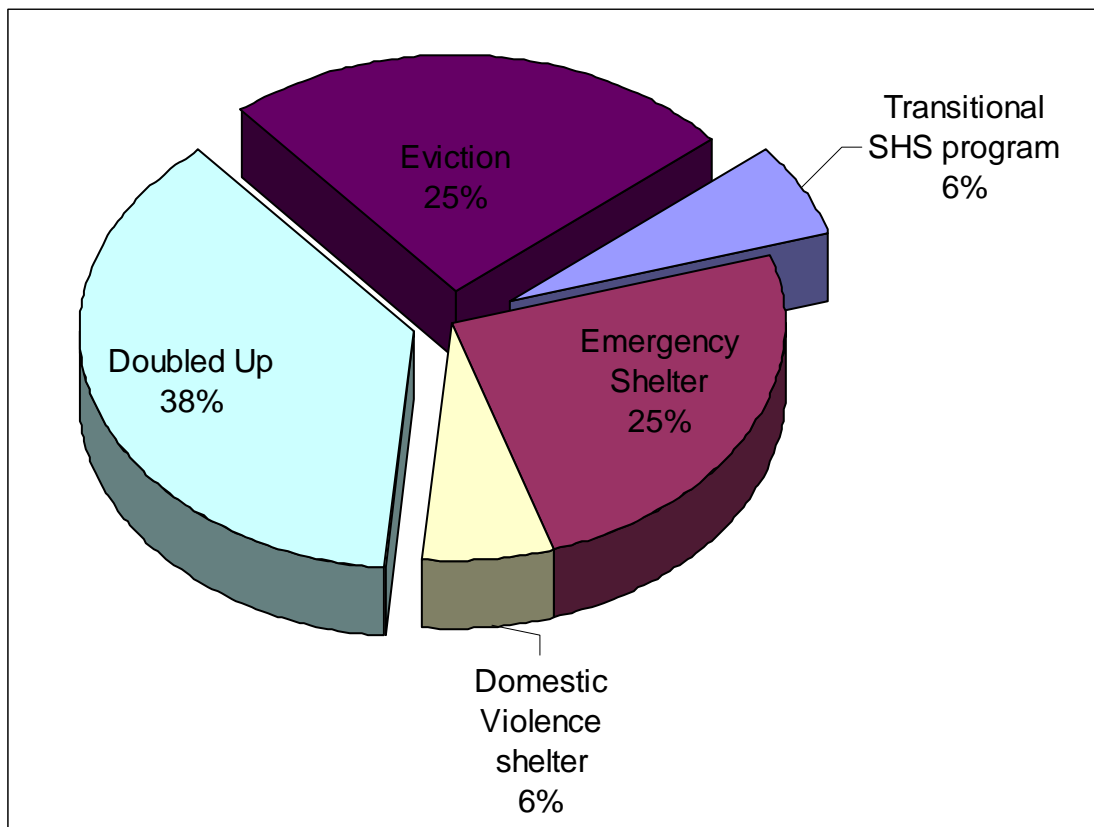
